Couple of things about membership. We currently have a little over 600 active members which is pretty good for us. We also have over 100 members that don't renew every year, which is a bit concerning. While this is actually slightly better than the state average, it seems way too high to me. 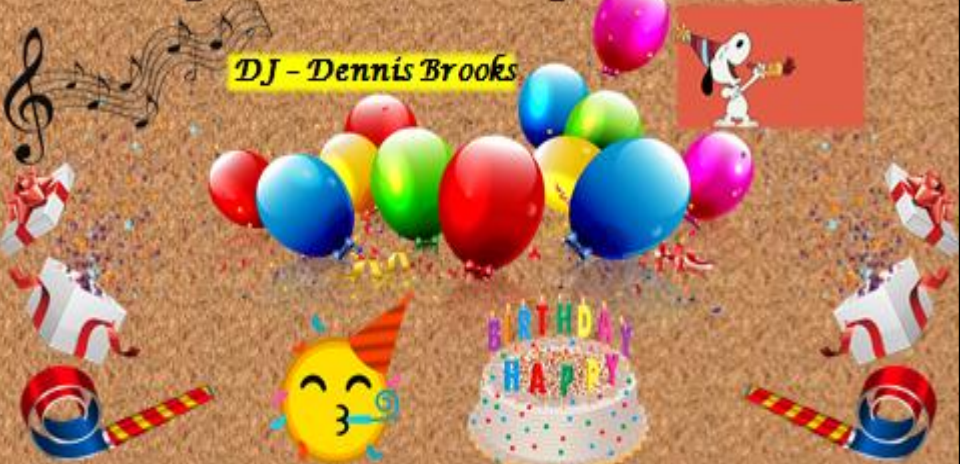
