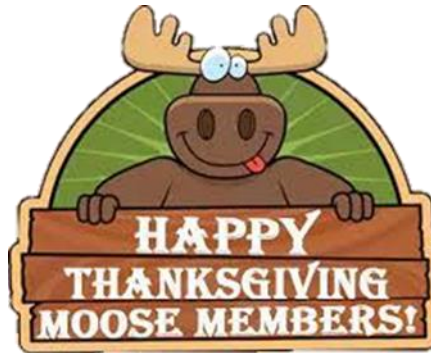

This is in addition to our year-round barrels for food, clothing, and pet food which normally goes to SnowCap. Big thanks to Steve and Cheryl for regularly taking those items in for us btw. New unwrapped toys are being accepted for our annual toy drive for Randall Children's Hospital toy drive, too.

In related news, we will be closed on Thanksgiving day and won't open until noon on 11/26 so there won't be breakfast that day so that our kitchen staff can have the long weekend off.

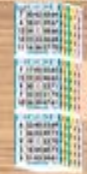

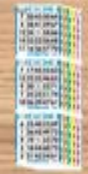

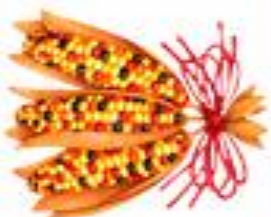
