FIRE UPDATE

As most of you know, we were attacked by an arsonist in the early morning of July 7th. Two windows were broken out and two fires were started in the entryway and in my office. The effects from the fires were minimal but the smoke and water damage will lead to some significant restoration. We were fortunate that the fire alarm worked as designed and that there were no injuries. BTW Gresham Fire, Gresham Police, and the investigators have all been terrific throughout. We also have good insurance enabling us to get the work underway ASAP. However, that work means that the front entrance will be sealed off likely until mid September or so. We will continue to stay open (except the predetermined Tuesdays) and ask that you use the East door entrance in the meantime. Please note that we're making the front row over there temporary handicapped spots so please leave those spaces to the people who need them. Lastly, it's been so touching to receive the warm wishes and donations from members to help offset the insurance deductible, especially when we didn't even suggest doing so. It's a nice reminder of how much this lodge means to so many of us. Let's hope that the person who did this gets the help he needs and that we can continue on as an even closer Moose family.


