## Administrator's Message

Howdy, folks. I've got some more good news to report. We ended up our 2025-2026 fiscal year on 4/30 with 685 active members - an outstanding increase of 74. And, the 124 new members we enrolled last year were sponsored by 69 different members which is also great. Special recognition is deserved to these ten people who hit the benchmark of sponsoring five new members last year: Patty Waters, Ken King, myself, Emilie Urick, Bruce Rickert, Tiffany Lenocker, Terri Ballard, Daphne McLenithan, Jon Godden, and Lois Stephenson. Please remember that we're looking for quality over quantity, however. We're thankful to have a great group of recent members and we're always looking to diversify and let others know about our little hidden gem but please use your best judgement. Sponsoring a new member is easy but if you have any questions just ask someone. To that point, the new Moose International campaign waives the \$20 application fee if the applicant pays for two years and does it on-line. The on-line application can be found at [mooseintl.org](http://mooseintl.org) and is pretty easy to navigate. BTW, more and more people are paying for two or more years at a time. This means you won't have to deal with renewing every year and getting a phone call from me or our retention committee to remind you. As for becoming a lifetime member, the cost is \$1200 for members of less than 15 years, 15-19 years is \$960, 20-24 is \$840, 25-29 is \$720, 30-34 is \$600, 35-39 is \$480, 40-44 is \$360, and after a short 50 years they finally give you a "free" lifetime membership. Looking back, I sure wish I had the foresight to take the lifetime option so long ago.

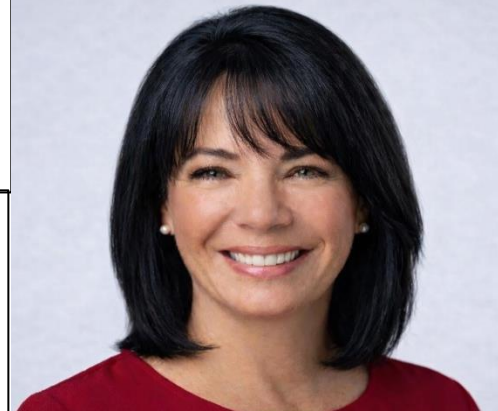

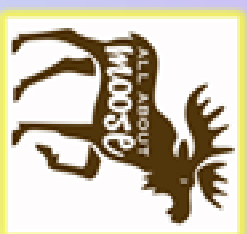
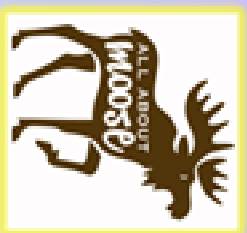
